TOWN OF DUCK LAKE BYLAW NO. 2020-02

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF DUCK LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF PRIVATE SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEMS

The Council of the Town of Duck Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. Any building or portion thereof situated lower than the finished grade elevation of the property shall be protected from discharge from the sanitary sewer service line by means of a backflow prevention device. Said device shall be installed according to and meet with, all applicable plumbing codes enforced at the time of installation.
- 2. The sanitary sewer service connection for any building shall not be discharged directly by any storm water or ground water source other than by means of a pumping unit installed in a storm or ground water collection sump.
- 3. Direct connection of any perimeter weeping tile or similar water collection system into the sanitary sewer service connection pipe is prohibited. Weeping tile systems shall drain water into sump pits for discharge into the sanitary sewer collection system by means of a pump.
- 4. Direct connection of eave trough downspouts or roof drain systems into the sanitary sewer service connection pipe is prohibited. All roof drains shall be caused to drain directly to the exterior of the building to a point above the finished grade elevation of the property.
- 5. Where storm water collection systems are in need of repair and, when it can be shown that the contravention to this bylaw indeed exists, all efforts by the contravening party to alter the configuration of the repaired drainage system to conform to this bylaw shall be made.
- 6. Penalty for any violation of any of these regulations shall be \$150.00 with a time limit for the property owner to affect work to remediate the violation of this bylaw. When the time limit as set by resolution of Council has elapsed without the required remedy being undertaken by the property owner, the Town will cause the required work to be completed and shall charge the expense of that work to the property owner.
