

DUCK LAKE TRANSFER STATION

Open the **THIRD** Saturday of every month

Summer hours: May 1 – October 31, 10:00 AM – 4:45 PM

Winter hours: November 1 – April 30, 10:00 AM – 2:45 PM

BIN: All material that is not suitable for the burnable pile must go in the bin, with the exception of items not allowed at any time. **Only CLEAR bags accepted.**

BURNABLE PILE: Only clean untreated, unpainted wood and branches, etc. allowed. All other wood in the bin. (No bags allowed in burn pile)

THE FOLLOWING IS NOT ALLOWED AT THE TRANSFER STATION AT ANY TIME:

Agricultural Waste - twine, grain bags, bale wrap, spoiled grain.

Animal carcasses

Batteries

Biomedical Waste – human waste, anatomical or infectious, infectious animal waste, microbiological waste, blood & body fluid waste, medical sharps

Concrete

Demolition/Construction materials.

Domestic sewage or sludge

Freezer, refrigerator, air conditioner, etc., anything that contained or contains Freon.

Hazardous waste – Adhesives, Aerosols, Household batteries, cleaners, corrosives, solvents, mercury or fluorescent tubes, oxidizers, poisons, pharmaceuticals, propane cylinders, asbestos, explosives, radioactive materials.

Herbicides

Household waste/Food Waste (Loraas curbside pickup available)

Large renovation project waste.

Industrial Waste – lime, sulfur, asbestos, contaminated soil, empty chemical containers, carbon, caustic acids, sludge, and sump water.

Liquid waste

Oil by-products– used oil, jugs, pails, filters

Paint

Pesticides.

Petroleum products, remains or by-products.

Recyclable materials (Loraas curbside pickup available).

Shingles.

Tires

Vehicle parts.

Fees

Clean Wood Pile - Free.

Bin: Partial loads - \$10.00 (minimum fee)
½ ton - \$50.00
1 ton - \$100.00

Outside landfill hours – an additional \$40.00, with arrangements made at the Town Office.

Small Appliances- (washer, dryer, range, microwave, water softener, water heaters) - \$40.00.

****NOTE- Cannot be over top of container***
