## Queen's Platinum Jubilee Medal Recipients

The Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee Medal was created to celebrate the 70th anniversary year of Her late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II's Accession to the Throne. The medal is a way for the province of Saskatchewan to honor Her late Majesty for her service to Canada. A total of 7,000 medals will be awarded to deserving citizens.

To receive the medal, a person had to be a resident of Saskatchewan or have a link to Saskatchewan; have made a contribution to Canada, Saskatchewan, or to a particular region or community; and were alive on February 6, 2022, the 70th anniversary of Her Majesty's Accession to the Throne.





Duck Lake's well deserved recipients are Jocelyn Pelletier (posthumously) for the R.M. and Denis and Rachelle Poirier for the Town.

As a busy farmwife and mother of two boys, *Jocelyn* somehow found the time to be very active in the community.

A strong supporter of education, she sat on the Stobart School Board, the Regional Library board as president and as School Division Trustee.

Jocelyn was also very active in volunteering as President of the Auxiliary Club for the Goodwill Manor, as exercise programmer for the Duck Lake Seniors and for fundraiser various local organization such as Duck Lake Museum, Churches, Lions Club and various community events.

Jocelyn enjoyed music and

was very generous in sharing her talents with the Blessed Sacrament Church playing the organ as well as playing her violin for the Goodwill Manor residents and for local events with her band called the "Hometown Girls".

As long term Educators at Stobart, <u>Denis and</u>
<u>Rachelle Poirier</u> have been involved with a multitude of groups and organizations through out the years. Groups such as the Duck Lake Seniors, Recreation Boards, Scouts, Curling Club, Mental Health Ass., Board of Trade, just to name a few.
