Dear Residents:

On Tuesday, March 17, 2020, a special council meeting was held to address our municipal response to COVID-19. As a local government, the Town of Duck Lake is taking direction from provincial and federal governments, and the Chief Medical Officer.

As a preventative measure and to ensure the continued health and safety of the entire community, all Town-owned facilities will be closed to the public effective Friday, March 20th until further notice. Council will revisit this directive at the next regular Council meeting on April 8th and advise further at that time. This includes the Town office, Landfill, RIC, library and all recreation facilities.

Please note that essential services will not be interrupted. Water, sewer, LORAAS garbage and recycling pickup, snow removal, and fire and rescue services will continue as usual.

Town Office staff will still receive phone calls and emails during normal office hours. Payments can be made online or by mail. For emergency situations please contact the office and we will do our best to accommodate you.

The Town of Duck Lake Council strongly recommends that all residents, clubs, groups and organizations of any kind do not hold any social events or gatherings. We encourage everyone to follow the guidelines of the World Health Organization to reduce the spread.

The Town of Duck Lake is closely monitoring developments relating to COVID-19 and will review and change as the situation evolves.
